Where a Student is a resident or affiliate of a Residential College, such minor penalties as specified in the Residential College Code of Conduct vii. Community service, for a period not exceeding 8 hours viii. Exclusion from Award for up to one year 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> i. Fine not exceeding ten Penalty units and/or a restitution payment ii. Withdrawal of Services for a period not exceeding 3 months iii. Residential College Exclusion from all Residential Colleges iv. Residential College Expulsion v. Exclusion from Award for up to three years vi. Exclusion vii. Expulsion viii. Revocation of Award
